The committee viewed a 12-minute animate of what it means to make a major shift in education and why it is becoming increasingly more important to meet students' needs in a less traditional manner. The committee engaged in a lengthy discussion around some of the barriers that the education system can sometimes present to our students (such as being moved along by grade level/age when that might not be the most appropriate way to be "moved on.") Conversely, there are other barriers to making large scale changes such as resources and support for educators. These are key ideas for the Strategic Planning Team to keep in mind when undertaking the upcoming Strategic Plan, and Loren Andrews requested that a menu of important background knowledge tools (podcasts, videos such as the one the group viewed, articles, books, etc.) be compiled to help frame conversation for the Strategic Planning Committee.
